

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon, by and through its Board of Forestry, is entitled to a Land Patent pursuant to Sec. 4(b)(3) of the Act of October 15, 1966; 16 U.S.C. 668dd, for the following described lands:

Willamette Meridian, Oregon

Sec. 18, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ .
- T. 28 S., R. 7 E.,  
Sec. 34, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ .

The areas described aggregate 881.92 acres, according to the official plats of the surveys of the said lands on file in the Bureau of Land Management.

NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said State of Oregon, the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said lands with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said State of Oregon forever;

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO THE UNITED STATES from the lands so granted:

1. A right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States. Act of August 30, 1890, 26 Stat. 391; 43 U.S.C. 945;
2. That road right-of-way, OR 14365, and all appurtenances thereto, constructed by the United States through, over, or upon the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18, T. 39 S., R. 6 E., W.M., and the right of the United States its agents or employees, to maintain, operate, repair, or improve the same so long as needed or used by the United States;
3. A road right-of-way as reserved under Right-of-Way No. OR 34765, pursuant to Title V of the Act of October 21, 1976, 43 U.S.C. 1767 as to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 34, T. 28 S., R. 7 E., W.M., and the right to enforce all or any of the terms and conditions of the right-of-way, including the right to renew it or extend it upon its termination; and

2. Such rights for telephone line purposes as United Telephone Company of the Northwest, or its successors in interest may have pursuant to right-of-way OR 37546, as to the S $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 3, T. 29 S., R. 7 E., W.M. Act of October 21, 1976, 90 Stat. 2776, 43 U.S.C. 1761.
