LOGGER'S AND WOODWORKER'S LIEN

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned (hereinafter called the "claimant") claims a lien upon logs, lumber, cants cut on Shoe Timber Sale, Klamath District, Winema National Forest,

being about five hundred fifty-seven thousand five hundred board feet more or less, which were obtained, handled, manufactured and/or transported in Klamath County, State of Oregon, are marked thus some marked G-5 and are now lying in Chiloquin Forest Products; Homestead Log Homes, White City; and in log decks in the woods,

manufacturing for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in (Obtaining—manufacturing—handling—transporting timbers or wood products)

The name of the owner of the above described timber and/or wood products is Larry Spivey, for whose benefit said labor was performed and assistance rendered. The following is a description of the said labor performed and the said assistance rendered at the request of said owner: timber fell, limbed, bucked, skidded and decked.

The close of the furnishing of said labor assistance was September 1, 1985; 60 days have not elapsed since the date just mentioned.

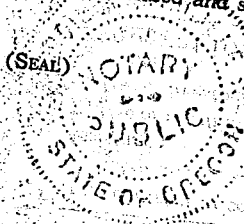

The foregoing lien is authorized by ORS 87.222(1). ORS 87.242 provides in part:
"(1) A person claiming a lien created by ORS 87.216 to 87.232 shall file a written notice of claim of lien with the recording officer of the county in which the lien debtor resides, or, if the lien debtor is a business, the county in which the lien debtor has its principal place of business not later than 60 days after the close of the furnishing of the labor, services or materials."
ORS 87.246 provides:
"The recording officer of the county shall record the notices filed under ORS 87.242 in a book kept for that purpose and called 'index of liens upon chattels.'"
ORS 87.252 provides:
"When a lien claimant files a notice of claim of lien as required by ORS 87.242, he shall send forthwith a copy of the notice to the owner of the chattel to be charged with the lien by registered or certified mail sent to him at his last-known address."
