The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Conclusions of Law:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

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- The proposed use is conditionally permitted in the zone within which it is proposed to be located.
- The location, size, design and operating characteristics of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan.
- The location, size, design and operating characteristics 9 of the proposed use will be compatible with and will not have sig-10 nificant adverse affects on the appropriate development and use of 11 abutting property owners and the surrounding neighborhood so long 12 as the conditions set forth hereinbelow are followed.
- The granting of this Conditional Use Permit is consis-14 tent with the goals of the L.C.D.C.
 - 5. The granting of this Conditional Use Permit is subject to the following conditions:
 - The applicant shall register the airstrip with the Oregon State Aeronautics Division.
 - The airstrip shall be used as defined in the Klamath County Land Development Code under the definition of "airport, personal use," that is: an airstrip restricted except for aircraft emergencies, to use by the owner, and, on an infrequent and occasional basis, by his invited guests, and by commercial aviation activities in connection with agriculture operations. No aircraft may be based on a personal use airport other than those owned or controlled by the owner of the airstrip.
 - There shall be no more than two aircraft kept

permanently at this airstrip. 2

The applicant shall follow all conditions of the Oregon State Aeronautics Division as well as those of all other 3 applicable state and/or federal agencies. FINDINGS OF FACT: 5 6

The Conditional Use Permit has been conditionally granted based on the following Findings of Fact:

- This is a request for a personal use airport in the FR 9 zone. The applicant is the owner of approximately 360 acres off 10 Highway 140 east of Bly. As shown in Exhibit "H", the airstrip 11 has been in existence on the property since 1973. The applicant is resurfacing and upgrading. He is upgrading a 2,600' x 60' strip off Highway 140. The surrounding area is national forest, BLM land and some private parcels. 14
- 15 2. Notice of this hearing was sent to surrounding property 16 owners, to concerned public agencies and published in the <u>Herald</u> 17 18
- 3. The property soils are in capability class VII. airport is in juniper-sagebrush type area and will not result in 19 20 removal of productive agricultural land.
- 21 4. The area has no timber productivity rating and the only trees are small, scattered juniper. The only forest use of this 23 property among those listed by Goal 4 is wildlife habitat.
- 24 5. The applicant is basically upgrading an existing airport. The property is in a deer wintering range. This proposal has been sent to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and no comment 26 27 has been received from them.
- 28 The property is in a high wild-fire hazard area. C.U.P. 33-85/LeonDeMendoza

water resource is available on the property and there is fire-1 2 fighting equipment at Bly, 4½ miles to the west. The proposal would provide the applicant with an airport for his personal use. The applicant has previously obtained a Conditional Use Permit for a camping area for recreational travelers on Highway 140. The national forest, BLM and timber company lands are extensively used for hunting, fishing, hiking and other forms of outdoor recreation. 8 9 There are electrical lines of concern in the area. 10 Pacific Power has done an on-site investigation and has no objections to this application being granted. 12 9. No one testified in opposition to the granting of this Conditional Use Permit and there has been no evidence presented that there would be any adverse affects on the appropriate development and use of abutting property owners and the sur-16 / rounding area. 17 The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of 18 Fact, accordingly orders as follows: 19 That real property described as "being generally located on the south side of Highway 140, approximately 41 miles east of Bly, and more particularly described as the SW4, NE4 and SE4, NW4 of Section 17, Township 37, Range 15, Klamath County, Oregon, is hereby conditionally granted a Conditional Use Permit in

accordance with the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 45.2, and, henceforth, will be allowed a personal use airport in the FR zone.
