

A lien is hereby claimed by Lindahl Lumber Company for the performance of labor and the furnishing of materials used in the construction an improvement at Julees Motel in Chemult, Klamath County, Oregon, more fully described as follows:

Beginnning at an iron pin on the Easterly right of way line of the Dalles-California Highway which lies S. 19 degrees 24' E. a distance of 649.2 feet from the Southwest corner of Block 8 of Chemult, Oregon, and running thence continuing S. 19 degrees 24' E. along the Easterly right of way line of the Dalles-California Highway a distance of 242.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 70 degrees 36' E. a distance of 330 feet to an iron pin on the Westerly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad right of way, which pin is also on the forty line; thence N. 20 degrees 54' W. along the Westerly right of way line of the S. P. right of way a distance of 242.4 feet to an iron pin thence S. 70 degrees 36' W. a distance of 325.6 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, said tract containing 1.8 acres, more or less, in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 27 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian.

Lien claimant, Lindahl Lumber Company, entered into an agreement for the performance of labor and the furnishing of materials for the above construction on or about September 24, 1985, with John Post, aka Charles John Power, president of Julee's Sun Bear Resorts, Inc., an Oregon corporation, the owner or reputed owner of the improvement, and said entity at all times had knowledge of the construction and claimant was employed to furnish labor and materials to perform said contract by the owner of the improvement. Claimant commenced construction with the delivery of materials on September 28, 1985, and completed all work on October 27, 1985.

The following is a true statement of claimant's demand after deduction of all just credits and offsets:

Labor	\$ 800.00
Materials	2,769.57
Recording fees	4.00
Less all just credits and offsets	-0-
Total due	\$3,573.57

A lien is claimed for the amount of \$3,577.57 upon the above-described improvement and upon so much of the site upon which it is constructed that may be required for the convenient use and occupation of the improvement constructed on the site, to be determined at the time of foreclosure of this lien.

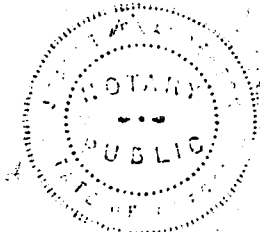
