

The undersigned Declarants wish to amend the Declaration of Shield Crest, A Planned Community, recorded on the 16th day of March, 1984, in Volume M-84, Pages 4256 through 4266 in the Records of the clerk of the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, for the purpose of compliance with the requirements of the State of Oregon.

Paragraph 18(A) through (E) page 10 and 11 provide for the annexation of property as described in the legal description. This property known as TRACT 1245, FIRST ADDITION TO SHIELD CREST containing 34 lots was filed on August 29, 1985, in the clerk's office of Klamath County, Oregon. There are now a total of 81 lots under the provisions of the DECLARATION OF SHIELD CREST, A PLANNED COMMUNITY.

Paragraph 13(E) Page 6, LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY. DELETE the following starting in the middle of the paragraph "However, upon Lots 1, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 9 of Block 1 and Lots 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 of Block 2 three sheep or two cows, two horses or a cow and a horse may be kept with their lambs, calves and colts, ----". ADD "However, animals as described may be kept on the following listed lots considering each number as one head: including offspring.

TRACT 1172, SHIELD CREAT

Block 1, Lots 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, & 9

Block 2, Lots 1, 2, 3, & 12

three sheep or two cows or two horses

TRACT 1245, FIRST ADDITION TO SHIELD CREST

Block 4, Lots 1, 2, 4, & 5 . . . three sheep or two cows or two horses

Lots 9 and 10 ten sheep or four horses or four cows

Lot 15 20 sheep or eight horses or eight cows

Lot 16 25 sheep or ten horses or ten cows

Block 5, Lots 1, 2, & 3 . . . three sheep or two cows or two horses

Lots 11 and 12 . . . eight sheep or three horses or three cows

Lot 13 30 sheep or twelve horses or twelve cows

Lot 14, 15, & 16 . . 12 sheep or five horses or five cows."

IN ADDITION, the following is to be added to Paragraph 18, Page 11:

CREST "(F) IRRIGATION - TRACT 1245, FIRST ADDITION TO SHIELD

Present and future owners of Lot 15, Block 4, and Lot 13, Block 5, are subject to laws of the State of Oregon and the rules, regulations, by-laws and assessments of the KLAMATH BASIN IRRIGATION DISTRICT.

Present and future owners of Lots 16, Block 4, and Lots 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, Block 5, are subject to the laws of the State of Oregon and the rules, regulations, by-laws and assessments of PINE GROVE IRRIGATION DISTRICT.

FURTHER: Owners shall pay Pine Grove Irrigation District assessment existing in 1985 without reduction for granted easement to the District and without regard to actual acres served. The total acreage assessment of said District within the First Addition to Shield Crest shall be prorated to the lots within First Addition Shield Crest lots which are also within Pine Grove Irrigation District, and the district will assess each new owner a percentage of the total assessment according to the size of lot owned as follows:

BLOCK 4, Lot 16	13.50 Acres	27.90%
BLOCK 5, Lot 14	6.60 Acres	13.64%
Lot 15	6.06 Acres	12.52%
Lot 16	6.10 Acres	12.61%
Lot 17	6.45 Acres	13.33%
Lot 18	9.68 Acres	20.00%

Owners shall order irrigation water from the Pine Grove Irrigation District ditch rider 24 hours in advance of use, subject to said ditch rider's approval. Owners shall notify ditch rider when irrigation ceases. Unauthorized use of Pine Grove Irrigation District water may terminate by action of the ditch rider and the lot owner will be subject to termination of future deliveries by Pine Grove Irrigation District.
