NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a vein or lode of locatable mineral bearing rock in place upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Oregon, have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post or monument at the point of discovery, marked Post No. 1. The name of the claim is:

H.P.H.R. #3 (three)

Claim, further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 (Discovery Post), thence
 approximately 141 feet in a Southerly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence
 " 290 feet in a Easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence
 " 1480 feet in a Northerly direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence
 " 290 feet in a Westerly direction to an end post marked No. 5, thence
 " 290 feet in a Westerly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence
 " 1480 feet in a Southerly direction to a corner post marked No. 7, thence
 " 290 feet in a Easterly direction to said end post marked No. 2.

The locators claim

direction from point of discovery to the 1359 feet in a Northerly
 feet in the opposite direction from point of discovery to the 141 end line and 141
290 feet on each side of the middle of said Southerly end line and

and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 1080 (approx.) feet from a natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity,

to-wit: post #7 is 1080 feet (approx.) in an Easterly direction from the Southwest corner of Section 19 (as described below and as surveyed by the U.S.G.S.)

The general course or strike of the vein or lode as nearly as may be determined is indeterminate due to the disseminated nature of the deposit with reference to the natural object
 This claim is situated in the Southwest Quarter (designate quarter section) of Section 19 (nineteen), Township 29 South, Range 5 East, of the Willamette Meridian, as surveyed by the U.S. Government.

The end lines of the claim are parallel to each other. The adjoining claims are

H.P.H.R. #2 on the West;
H.P.H.R. #14 on the North;
and H.P.H.R. #4 on the East.

This notice is placed conspicuously at discovery post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner and both center ends. The location of this claim is distinctly marked on the ground so that the boundaries of the claim may be readily traced. In construing this location notice, the singular includes the plural and vice versa, where the context so requires.
