- 4. All the geothermal steam and associated geothermal resources in the land so patented, and to it or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine, and remove such deposits, upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the provisions and limitations of the Act of December 24,
- 5. Pursuant to the authority contained in the Acts of May 20, 1920 (43 U.S.C. 375), May 16, 1930 (43 U.S.C. 424-424e), and March 31, 1950 (43 U.S.C. 375b-375f), there is reserved to the United States and its assigns an easement for the construction, reconstruction, operation, and maintenance of laterals and drains for irrigation and drainage purposes, together with appurtenant uses, over, across, and through all those portions of land lying within (1) 25 feet on the southerly side and a variable width of from 25 feet to 45 feet on the northerly side of the centerline of the C-4-n Lateral; and (2) 45 feet on either side of the centerline of the No. 20 Drain, said portions of land being more particularly identified and described in the Bureau of Reclamation Plat No. 12-201-4424 dated June 23, 1971, on file with the Klamath Project, Bureau of Reclamation; and there is further reserved to the United States the right to exclude any occupancy or use of said portions of land by Clyde M. Horsley and Almeta Horsley, their heirs or assigns, except that which may be expressly authorized by the United States
