

NOTICE OF LIEN

HIGH TECH DIESEL, INC., an Oregon

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that HIGH TECH DIESEL, INC. claims a lien upon that certain International Dumptruck, Model 400DCF400 Transstar 104, Serial Number 559644Y030090, Oregon License Number T380806, which vehicle is now in the possession of THOMAS A. and JUDITH M. WASSON at 2211 Angle Street, Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon, 97601; said vehicle is generally kept, when not in actual operation, at 2211 Angle Street, Klamath Falls, Klamath County Oregon; for the agreed charges for labor and services performed by the Claimant, and for materials furnished by the Claimant in connection therewith; and THOMAS A. and JUDITH M. WASSON, the owners or purported owners of said vehicle, employed the Claimant to perform said service and to provide said materials and labor under the following terms and conditions:

Claimant was to remove and replace heads, remove the cylinder kits, remove the engine, provide and install a rebuilt engine, rebuild the motor mounts, weld the frame rails for mounts, dress the new engines to International Harvester specifications, rebuild accessory components, install new belts and hoses, provide and install a new clutch, remove and replace the engine pan, re-spec for an international truck,

and the owner of said vehicle agreed to pay for all of the parts and for \$28.00 per hour labor, and agreed to reimburse HIGH TECH DIESEL, INC., for any and all core charges that were rejected by the SOUTHERN OREGON DISTRIBUTOR for diesel engines, namely PACIFIC DIESEL, INC..

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1 THAT the Claimant thereby became entitled to \$10,769.00 representing the
2 material, labor and core charges, none of which has been paid except for the
3 sum of \$1,000.00 and the sum of \$5,800.00 leaving a balance due of \$3,969.00,
4 the amount of this lien, exclusive of the statutory costs and charges;

5 THAT the labor contract was faithfully performed and fully complied with
6 on the part of the Claimant, and the contract was completed and possession
7 of said vehicle was relinquished on the 20th day of November, 1985. Sixty
8 (60) days have not elapsed since that time;

9 THAT the amount claimed is a true and bona fide existing debt as of the
10 date of the filing of the Notice of Claim of Lien.

11 THAT the amount of Claimant's demand for such services is \$3,969.00, after
12 all setoffs, payments and counterclaims, and there is now due and owing thereon
13 the sum of \$3,969.00 to the Claimant;

14 THAT the date upon which payment was due to the Lien Claimant for his
15 labor, services and materials was November 20th, 1985;

16 THAT the parties agreed to allow thirty (30) days from that date as an
17 extended payment.
