THIS MATTER, having come on regularly to be heard on the 30th day of October, 1970, plaintiff appearing in person and with her attorney, Ronald I. Gevurtz, and the defendant making no appearance herein, and the default of the defendant having been duly entered of record,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That the plaintiff be and she is hereby granted an absolute Decree of Divorce and the marriage contract heretofore existing between the parties be and the same is hereby dissolved, said divorce to become effective on the 30 day of December, 1970, or, if appeal is taken, then upon determination on appeal, whichever is later, without further action of either party;

2. If either party shall die before said date, the marriage shall terminate immediately before such death, unless an appeal is pending; upon such death (if an appeal is pending), the estate of decedent shall be the nominal party, and the Supreme Court shall have the power to determine finally all matters presented on such appeal;

3. Any Will of either party antedating the date hereof is hereby null and void, its terms express a contrary intention;

4. The plaintiff party is entitled to cohabit with the defendant party after the date hereof;

5. The plaintiff be awarded the care, custody, and

control of the minor child of the parties, namely, DONALD
MORAN, born January 13, 1953, subject to defendant's rights
of reasonable and reasonable visitations;

6. That the defendant be, and he is hereby directed
to pay to the plaintiff for the care, support, and maintenance
of the minor child of the parties that portion of the social
security benefit designated for the purpose;

7. That the plaintiff be awarded the property located
at 2440-2440-1/2 White Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon, more specifi-
cally described as:

Lot 10, Block 306
DARROW ADDITION, in the
City of Klamath Falls,
County of Klamath.

Plaintiff is hereby directed to sell the aforementioned property
and to split equally the proceeds with the defendant;

8. That the defendant be awarded the property located
at 1203 and 1225 Wooddale Road, Klamath Falls, Oregon, more specifi-
cally described as:

MIRACLES SUBDIVISION No. 1,
Tract 58 and Tract 59, in the
City of Klamath Falls, County
of Klamath.

Defendant is awarded said property free and clear of all right,
title, and interest of the plaintiff, provided, however, that he
shall release his obligation thereon and hold and save the plain-
tiff harmless from any liability;

9. That the plaintiff be awarded the home located at
2427 White Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon, more specifically described
as:

Lot 15, Block 301
DARROW ADDITION, in the
City of Klamath Falls, County
of Klamath.

Plaintiff is awarded said property free and clear of all right,
title, and interest of the defendant.

 13 plaintiff, and that plaintiff be awarded the 270 Savage Rifle,
 14 free and clear of all right, title, and interest of the defendant;

15 13. That defendant be awarded the 1955 Chevrolet
 16 Station Wagon, the Harley Davidson Motorcycle, the 1951 Chevrolet
 17 Sedan, and the 1953 International Three-Quarter-Ton Truck, free
 18 and clear of all right, title, and interest of the plaintiff;

19 14. That plaintiff be awarded the 1966 Volkswagon
 20 automobile, free and clear of all right, title, and interest of
 21 the defendant, provided, however, that she shall assume the obli-
 22 gation thereon, and hold and save the defendant harmless from any
 23 liability thereon; and

24 15. That defendant be, and he is hereby ordered to
 25 pay plaintiff's attorney's fees in the amount of \$ 300.00 ,
 26 and costs incurred in the amount of \$ 59.70 .

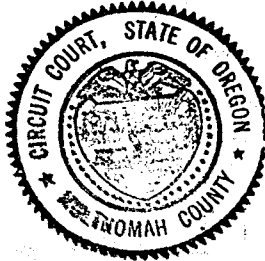
