The annual interest rate during the term of this Contract is variable; it cannot increase by more than one (1) percent except to maintain the sulvency of the Department of Veterans' Affairs. The Seller may per odically change the interest rate by Administrative Rule pursuant to the provisions of ORS 407.375 (4). The initial are ual interest rate shall be 6.7 percent per a murti.

- PRE-PAYMENTS. Buyer may prepay all or any portion of the balance due on the Contract at any time without penalty.
- PLACE OF PAYMENTS. All payments to Seller shall be made to Department of Veterans' Affairs at 700 Summer Street, N.E., Salem, Oregon 97310-1201, 15 uniesa Seller gives written notice to Buyer to make payments at sorile other place.
- WARRANTY DEED. Upon payment of the total purch see price for the property as provided for by this Contract and performances by Buyer of all other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Contract, Seller shall deliver to 3 yer a Warranty Deed, Such Warranty Deed shall warrant marketable title, except for those liens and endumbrance's referred to on page one of this Contract and those placed upon the proparty or suffered by Buyer after the date of this Contract.

#### SECTION 2. POSSESSION: MAINTENANCE

- POSSESSION. Buyer shall be entitled to possession of the property from and after the date of this Contract. It is understood, and agreed, however, that Buyer sall parmit Seller and its agents to enter the property of reasonable times, to inspect the property. Buyer shall not permit the premises to be vacant for more than thirty 30) consend dive days
- MAINTENANCE. Buyer shall keep all buildings, of his improvements, and landscape now existing, or which shall be placed on the property, in good condition and regar. Buyer thail not permit any waste or removal of the improvements, nor make any substantial improvements or alterations without the prior written consent of Sefer. Except for comestic use, Buyer shall not permit the cutting or removal of any lines, nor removal of any sand and gravel, without prior written consent of Seller.
- COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS. Buyer shall proxipity comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, directions, rules, and other requirements of all governmental authorities, upplicable to the use or occupancy of the property. In this compliance, Buyer shall promptly make all required repairs, alterations, and additions. Buyer may contest in glood faith any such requirements find withhold compilar be during any process ding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Seller's interest in the property is not jeopartizec.

#### SECTION 1. INSURANCE

- PROPERTY DIAMAGE INSUFFANCE. Buyer shall get and keep policies, of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements (and any other endorserrents required by Suller) on an actual cash value basic covering all improvements on the property. Such insurance shall be in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any co-insurance clause. Insurance shall be made with loss payable to Seller and Buyer, as their respective interests may appear. In the event of loss, Buyer shall give immediate notice to Soller. Seller may make proof of loss if Buyer fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the loss. If Buyer fails to keep insurance in force. Seller may obtain insurance, and add this cost to the balance due on the Contract. The insurance cost shall be payable to Seller on demand.
- APPLICATION OF PROCEEDS. All proceeds of arry insurance on the property shall be held by Seller. If Buyer chooses to restore the property, Buyer shall repair or replace the damagest or destroyed portion of the property in a manner satisfactory to Seller. Upon satisfactory proof of restoration, Seller shall pay or reimburse Buyer from the insurance proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration. If Euyer chooses not to restore the property, Seller shall keep a sufficient amount of the proceeds to pay all amounts due under this Contract, and shall pay the balance of the insurance proceeds to Buyer. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt, and which Buyer has not committed to the repair or restoration of the property, shall be used to pay first accrued interest and then the principal balance du s on the Contract.

### SECTION 4. EMIHENT DOM/LIN

If a condemning authority takes all or any portion of the property. Buyer and Seller shall share in the condemnation proceeds in proportion to the values of their respective interests in the property. Sale of the property in lieu of condemnation shall be treated as a taking of the property.

This instrument shall constitute a security agreement within the meaning of the Uniform Commercial Code with respect to any personal property included within the description of the property. Upon request of Seller, Buyer shall execute any necessary financing statements in the form required by the Uniform Commercial Code and shall Me the starements at Buyer's expense. Without further aut vorization from Buyer, Selfer may at any time file copies of the Contract as financing statements. Upon default under the terms of this Contruct, Buyer shall, within three (5) days of receipt of written demand from Seller, assemble the personal property and make it available to Seller.

#### SECTIONIS, DEFAULT

- EVENTS OF DEFAULT. Time is of the essance of this Contract. A default shall occur under any of the following circumstances:
  - Failure of Buyer to make any paymer twhen payment is due. No notice of default and no opportunity to cure shall be required if during any twelve (12)month period Seller has already sent three (3) notices to Buyer concerning non-payment or late payment under this Contract.
  - Failure of Buyer to perform any other of legation in this Contract in addition to payment. Buyer must perform obligation within thirty (30) days after (b) receiving Notice of Default from Sellar, Such Notice shall specify the nature of the default.

- 6.2 REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. In the event of a default, S∈ ler may take any on 3 or more of the following steps:
  - (1) Declare the entire balance due on the Contract, including interest, in mediately due and payable;
  - (i) Foreclose this Contract by suit in equity:
  - (c) Specifically enforce the terms of this Contract by suit in equity:
  - (d) Exercise the rights and remedies of a secured partial of your median provided by the Uniform Commercial Code. Seller may exercise these rights and remedies with respect to any part of the property which constructes personal property in which Seller has a security interest.
  - (t) Choose to impose a late charge. The charge with of exceed five (5) cents per dollar of the payment in the event Buyer fails to make any payment within 10 days after it is due.
  - Declare this Contract to be void thirty (30) or more days after Sellerigines written notice to Buyer of Seller's intention to do so, unless the performance then due under this Contract is tendered or accomplished prior to the time stated. At the end of the thirty (30) days, all of Buyer's rights under this Contract shall cease without further act by Selfer Seller shall then be entitled to immediate possession of the property.   - Appoint a receiver. Seller shall be entitled to the copointment of a receiver as a matter of right.     - (+) Coffect all rents, reviewes, income, issuit, and profits from the property and apply such sums to the necessary expenses of use, operation, and management,
    - (4) Complete any construction in projects or the property, at the lens option. To complete that construction, receiver may pay all bills, borrow funds, employ constructors, and make any changes in plans and specifications that Seller deems appropriate.
