6 This matter having come on for hearing before the Klamath
7 County Hearings Officer on the 3rd Day of April, 1986, pursuant,
8 to Citation 6-86, issued on the 28th Day of February, 1986. The
9 respondent was Art Shimp. Klamath County was represented by
10 J.K. Lundahl, Planning Department, and Ray La Marche, Klamath
11 County Nuisance Abatement Officer. The Hearings Reporter was
12 Janet Libercajt.

The hearing was called to order, Klamath County having 13 presented evidence and rested, the respondent having presented 14 evidence, the Hearings Officer having taken testimony from 15 affected parties, Klamath County and the respondent having 16 presented such rebuttal evidence as deemed necessary, and the 17 hearing having been closed to further testimony. The Hearings 18 Officer being fully advised in the facts, issues of the law, 19 hereby issues the following Findings of Fact: 20

21 FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The respondent, Art Shimp, is a tenant at 2223 Patterson
 Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon. The respondent is before the
 Hearings Officer on a citation alleging that on property
 designated Residential in the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan
 and RM (Medium-Density Residential) in the Klamath County Zoning
 Ordinance, that respondent is in violation of one or more of the
 following provisions of the Klamath County Land Development Code:

Section 51.006(B); Keeping of large animals in А. a zone which does not permit the use. Section 51.006(B); Maintaining an auto wrecking в. yard without County permit or State license. C. Section 51.006(C); Keeping of small animals withour a Conditional Use Permit.

The Hearings Officer finds the named person is a tenant of the above-described property, that he has kept two horses, as 8 many as three pigs, chickens, ducks and rabbits on the subject 9 10 property. The Hearings Officer further finds under Klamath County Land Development Code, Section 12.001(B), that existing 11 12 uses made prior to the date of adoption of the Code on November 25, 1981, which are not altered, expanded, modified or 13 14 abandoned may be continued. The question thus becomes: 15 what use was the property put on and before November 25, 1981? 16 The Hearings Officer finds from clear, credible and 17 reliable testimony of adjacent property owners who have resided 18 at or owned adjacent property continuously since November 25, 19 1981, that the prior occupant kept at least one horse and both 20 rabbits and chickens and that those uses have continued to this 21 date. 22

4. Absent testimony to establish that the named person has 23 altered, expanded or modified the use by increasing the number of 24 small animals, the Hearings Officer dismisses allegation No. A. 25 Allegation B has been withdrawn by Klamath County, in 26 that the respondent has removed the auto bodies. The allegation 27 B is dismissed. 28

6. As to allegation No. A, the Hearings Officer specifically Violation 6-86/Shimp Page 2

finds from testimony adduced at hearing that pigs were not 1 2 introduced to the subject property nor raised on it until some date subsequent to November 25, 1981. The Hearings Officer con-3 cludes that the raising of pigs is therefore not an existing, 4 5 authorized use and finds the named person to be in violation and accordingly hereby orders the affected person to remove the sub-6 7 ject pigs from the subject property effective on the date of 8 this Order. This finding does not affect the keeping of less than two horses, however, as such a use will be permitted until 9 10 abandoned.

11 7. The Hearings Officer further orders respondent to cease
12 and desist and to refrain from any further introduction of pigs
13 or swine onto the subject property.

14 Based on representation by Klamath County that respondent 8. 15 is clearing conditions deemed to be a nuisance under the Klamath 16 County Nuisance Abatement Ordinance, but not cited herein further 17 action shall be stayed and respondent shall be allowed until 18 July 1, 1986, to remove all pigs from the property on the 19 following condition that the affected person shall cooperate with 20 Raymond La Marche, Klamath County Nuisance Abatement Officer, 21 in the removal of refuse and debris under provisions of the 22 Klamath County Nuisance Abatement Code.
