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# Notice of Location of Placer Claim

STATE of OREGON, County of Klamath, Mining District.

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do locate a placer claim of 16.0 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the High Providence Survey #2 (two) Claim, which is described as follows (fill out one of the two sections below):

This claim is situated in the Northeast (quarter section) of Section 1 (one), Township, 30 South, Range 6 East, of the Willamette Meridian, either as surveyed or as unsurveyed protracted if the land is unsurveyed, in the State of Oregon.
