IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Respondent be and he is hereby required to pay to Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 per month per child, as and for support, maintenance, health and education of the minor children until such time as each child graduates from high school, marries or becomes self-supporting, whichever sooner occurs.

[2] Real property located in Klamath Falls, Oregon, containing approximately 10 acres of a value of approximately \$3,000.00, which property is legally described as follows:

That portion of Lot 3, Block 17, situated south and east of a point S1100 ft. and W415 ft. from the Northeast corner of said Lot 3, Block 17, Klamath Falls Forest Estates, Sycon Unit, as recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Klamath County, Oregon.

[3] The 1976 Oldsmobile Omega automobile.

[4] 2 shares Transamerica stock.

[5] Banking accounts with Hygrade Federal Credit Union.

[6] Petitioner's personal effects and belongings in her possession.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Respondent be and he is hereby awarded as his sole and separate property, free and clear of any right, title, claim, lien or interest of the Petitioner, the following items of property:

Life Insurance Company; provided, however, that he shall be required to maintain the minor children as irrevocable beneficiaries thereof until such time as they are no longer dependent.

[4] Any and all banking accounts in Respondent's name.

[5] Respondent's personal effects and belongings in his possession.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Respondent be and he is hereby ordered and directed to assume, pay and hold the Petitioner harmless with regard to the following community obligations: Sears, \$150.00; Sylvia & Raymond Goddard, \$4,000.00; and Garnet & Lois Hamlin, \$1,000.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that from and after August 1, 1981, any property acquired by either party shall be the separate property of the party acquiring the same, and from and after said date any debts incurred by either party shall be the sole responsibility of the party incurring the same.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Respondent be and he is permanently restrained from bothering, molesting, harassing or interfering with the Petitioner at home, at work or wherever she might be.
