The Klamath 10 JUL M County Planning Department was represented by Kim Lundahl. The 11 33 Hearings Reporter was Janet Libercajt. 12 13 Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were no adjacent property owners 14 15 16 The following exhibits were offered, received, and made a 17 part of the record: 18 Klamath County Exhibit A, Staff Report 19 Klamath County Exhibit B, Plot Plan 20 Klamath County Exhibit C, Assessor's Map 21 Klamath County Exhibit D, Map of surrounding property owners 22 Klamath County Exhibit E, Letter from D.E.Q. 23 Klamath County Exhibit F, Letter from Health Department 24 Klamath County Exhibit G, Letter from D.E.Q. dated 4-4-86 25 The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence 26 submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following 27 28 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. The Conditional Use Permit herein is extended from a 1 review each two years to a review each five years. 2 3

The Klamath County Health Department need not make an inspection each month, but only when they determine such an inspection is necessary.

3. The applicant need not send the dumping records with 7 the names and addresses of each job to the Klamath County Health 8 Department; however, such records shall be maintained by the 9 applicant for review by appropriate agencies. 10

4. Other than modified hereinabove, all previous orders 11 with regard to this Conditional Use Permit shall remain in full 12 force and effect. 13

FINDINGS OF FACT: 14

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The continuance of this Conditional Use Permit with 15 modifications is based on the following Findings of Fact: 16 1. This Conditional Use Permit has operated for the last 17 year without any problems having occurred. 18

2. The applicant has fully cooperated with all concerned 19 agencies. 20

3. Notice of this hearing was sent to surrounding property 21 owners, to concerned public agencies, and published in the 22 Herald and News, the Klamath Falls newspaper. 23

4. No one appeared at the hearing, nor was any evidence 24 presented that there had not been full compliance with the 25 previous order herein. 26

5. The Planning Department has requested the above-mentioned 27 modifications, based on the cooperation of the applicant with all 28 concerned agencies, and upon Exhibit "G", a letter from the Renewal of C.U.P. 81-17/JNS Excavation
