This matter having come before the Court on the Motion of Petitioner, the Petitioner appearing by attorney James A. Hendershott; Respondent not appearing, having been duly served with certified true copies of the Summons and Petition for Dissolution herein in Lane County Oregon, and a Default heretofor having been entered against Respondent.

The Court finds it has jurisdiction of this matter; that the allegations of the Petition herein are true and that irreconcilable differences have caused the irremediable breakdown of their marriage; that one child was born during the marriage namely, Mercedes Brie Semone, born 10/31/77, and that Petitioner is not now pregnant.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That marriage between the parties is dissolved; the date on which this Judgment becomes finally effective to terminate the marriage relationship is on the 14 day of August, 1982;

2. That the minor child of the parties, Mercedes Brie Semone, be awarded to Petitioner subject to Respondent's reasonable right of visitation;

3. That Respondent at this time be required to pay child support to Petitioner herein in the amount of \$100.00 per month with the first such payment being due and payable on the 15th day of July, 1982 and a like payment being due and payable on the same day of each month thereafter until the child turns eighteen years of age or otherwise becomes emancipated or until she obtains the age of twenty-one years of age so long as said child is a "child attending school" as defined in ORS 107.108 or it's successors;

4. Petitioner shall establish a bank account for the sole purpose of receiving said support payments, shall

1 notify Respondent in writing within 10 days of the date of
 2 this Judgment of the account number and location of said

15 tioner within the last eleven (11) months;


