THIS CONTRACT, Made this 9 day of July, 1986, between
Michael B. Jager & Margaret H. Jager, husband and wife & Clark J. Kenyon, a married
man,
and Gilbert V. Nation, a single man

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the
seller agrees to sell unto the buyer and the buyer agrees to purchase from the seller all of the following de-
scribed lands and premises situated in Klamath County, State of Oregon, to-wit:

"YOU HAVE THE OPTION TO VOID YOUR CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT BY NOTICE TO THE SELLER IF
YOU DID NOT RECEIVE A PROPERTY REPORT PREPARED PURSUANT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS
OF THE OFFICE OF INTERSTATE LAND SALES REGISTRATION, U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND
URBAN DEVELOPMENT, IN ADVANCE OF, OR AT THE TIME OF YOUR SIGNING THE CONTRACT OR
AGREEMENT. IF YOU RECEIVED THE PROPERTY REPORT LESS THAN 48 HOURS PRIOR TO SIGNING
THE CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REVOKE THE CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT BY
NOTICE TO THE SELLER UNTIL MIDNIGHT OF THE THIRD BUSINESS DAY FOLLOWING THE CON-
SUMMATION OF THE TRANSACTION. A BUSINESS DAY IS ANY CALENDAR DAY EXCEPT SUNDAY, OR
THE FOLLOWING BUSINESS HOLIDAYS: NEW YEAR'S DAY, WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY, MEMORIAL
DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, LABOR DAY, VETERAN'S DAY, COLUMBUS DAY, THANKSGIVING, AND
CHRISTMAS."

IT IS MANDATORY THAT THE PURCHASER BE A MEMBER OF THE LITTLE DESCHUTES RIVER WOODS
OWNERS ASSOCIATION AND IS SUBJECT TO MAINTENANCE OF BOTH THE ACCESS ROAD AND THOSE
ROADS WITHIN SUBDIVISION TRACTS 1069, 1122, AND 1123 AS SPELLED OUT IN THE ARTICLES
OF ASSOCIATION RECORDED IN KLAMATH COUNTY ON MARCH 12, 1973, INSTRUMENT NO. 74116,
VOLUME M73, PAGE NO. 2591.

Lot 12 in Block 11 in Tract 1122
for the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred and 00/00-
(hereinafter called the purchase price), on account of which none
Dollars (\$...none...) is paid on the execution hereof (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the
seller); the buyer agrees to pay the remainder of said purchase price (to-wit: \$ 4,500.00) to the order
of the seller in monthly payments of not less than Forty Three and 00/00-
Dollars (\$...43.00) each,

payable on the 20 day of each month hereafter beginning with the month of August, 1986,
and continuing until said purchase price is fully paid. All of said purchase price may be paid at any time;
all deferred balances of said purchase price shall bear interest at the rate of 9 3/4 per cent per annum from
July 20, 1986 until paid, interest to be paid monthly, and * (in addition to
the minimum monthly payments above required. Taxes on said premises for the current tax year shall be pro-
rated between the parties hereto as of the date of this contract.

The buyer warrants to and covenants with the seller that the real property described in this contract is
used primarily for buyer's personal, family, household or agricultural purposes,
(B) for an organization or (even if buyer is a natural person) is for business or commercial purposes other than agricultural purposes.
The buyer shall be entitled to possession of said lands on July 20, 1986, and may retain such possession so long as
he is not in default under the terms of this contract. The buyer agrees that at all times he will keep the buildings on said premises, now or hereafter
erected, in good condition and repair and will not suffer or permit any waste or strip thereof; that he will keep said premises free from mechanic's
such liens and save the seller harmless therefrom and reimburse seller for all costs and attorney's fees incurred by him in defending against any
such liens; that he will pay all taxes hereafter levied against said property, as well as all water rents, public charges and municipal liens which here-
after lawfully may be imposed upon said premises, all promptly before the same or any part thereof become past due; that at buyer's expense, he will
insure and keep insured all buildings now or hereafter erected on said premises against loss or damage by fire (with extended coverage) in an amount
not less than \$ none in a company or companies satisfactory to the seller, with loss payable first to the seller and then to the buyer as
such liens, costs, water rents, taxes, or charges or to procure and pay for such insurance, the seller may do so and any payment so made shall be added to
the seller for buyer's breach of contract.

The seller agrees that at his expense and within 10 days from the date hereof, he will furnish unto buyer a title insurance policy in-
suring (in an amount equal to said purchase price) marketable title in and to said premises as of record, if any. Seller also agrees that when
and purchase price is fully paid and upon request and upon surrender of this agreement, he will deliver a good and sufficient deed conveying said
premises in fee simple unto the buyer, his heirs and assigns, free and clear of all encumbrances as of the date hereof and free and clear of all encumbrances
and all other liens, permits, or zoning by, through or under seller, excepting, however, further excepting all liens and encumbrances created by the buyer or his assigns.
And it is understood and agreed between said parties that time is of the essence of this contract, and in case the buyer shall fail to make the
payments above required, or any of them, punctually within ten days of the time limited thereto, or fail to keep any agreement herein contained, then
the seller at his option shall have the following rights: (1) to declare this contract null and void; (2) to declare the whole unpaid principal balance of
said purchase price with the interest thereon at once due and payable; and (3) to foreclose this contract by suit in equity, and in any of such cases,
all rights and interest created or then existing in favor of the buyer as against the seller hereunder shall utterly cease and determine and the right to the
possession of the premises above described and all other rights acquired by the buyer hereunder shall revert to and vest in said seller without any act
of re-entrance, or any other act of said seller to be performed and without any right of the buyer of return, reclamation or compensation for money paid
on account of the purchase of said property as absolutely, fully and perfectly as if this contract and such payments had never been made; and in case
of such default all payments thereafter made on this contract are to be retained by and belong to said seller as the agreed and reasonable rent of said
premises up to the time of such default. And the said seller, in case of such default, shall have the right immediately, or at any time thereafter, to
enter upon the land aforesaid, without any process of law, and take immediate possession thereof, together with all the improvements and appurtenances
thereon or thereto belonging.

The buyer further agrees that failure by the seller at any time to require performance by the buyer of any provision hereof shall in no way affect
his right hereunder to enforce the same, nor shall any waiver by said seller of any breach of any provision hereof be held to be a waiver of any suc-
ceeding breach of any such provision, or as a waiver of the provision itself.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$ 4,500.00. @However, the actual consid-
eration consists of or includes other property or value given or promised which is part of the consideration indicated which.①

In case suit or action is instituted to foreclose this contract or to enforce any of the provisions hereof, the buyer agrees to pay such sum as the
court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees to be allowed plaintiff in said suit or action and if an appeal is taken from any judgment or decree
of the trial court, the buyer further promises to pay such sum as the appellate court shall adjudge reasonable as plaintiff's attorney's fees on such
appeal.

In construing this contract, it is understood that the seller or the buyer may be more than one person; that if the context so requires, the singular
pronoun shall be taken to mean and include the plural, the masculine, the feminine and the neuter, and that generally all grammatical changes shall
be made, assumed and implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and to individuals.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said parties have executed this instrument in duplicate; it either of the un-
dersigned is a corporation, it has caused its corporate name to be signed and its corporate seal affixed hereto
by its officers duly authorized thereunto by order of its board of directors.
