## Notice of Location of Placer Claim

STATE of OREGON, County of Klamath

Mining District.

**NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN** That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do locate a placer claim of .160 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the Sunago SE #54 (Fifty-four)
