DECREE OF DISSOLUTION
OF MARRIAGE

THIS SUIT coming on to be heard by the Court on the 14th
day of August, 1986; Petitioner appearing by affidavit, and
by and through her attorney, NEAL G. BUCHANAN; the Respondent
appearing not, and the default of the Respondent having
heretofore been declared entered, and noted; the Court having
ordered that the ninety (90) day waiting period required
by ORS 107.065(1) be waived upon the grounds that the waiver
of the waiting period will ease the severe emotional strain
on Petitioner; and affidavit in lieu of hearing having been
filed, and the Court having reviewed the same; and there
being no request for findings of fact or conclusions of law,
the Court makes none except that the Court finds that the
Court has jurisdiction of the parties, and further that the
Court finds that there are irreconcilable differences making
continuation of the marriage impossible,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the marriage
contract heretofore existing between Petitioner and Respondent
shall be terminated and forever dissolved on September 14th,
1986.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that as 14985
2 between Petitioner and Respondent, Petitioner is awarded the
3 care, custody and control of the minor children born issue
4 of Petitioner's former marriage, to wit: Rocky Gaylin Layne, a
5 girl, age 17, born January 30, 1969; and Kirsten Nita Layne,

9 maintain any and all medical, dental, orthodontic, vision and
10 health insurance benefits that are available through his place
11 of employment by virtue of his disability benefits for the

13 benefit of the Petitioner.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Petitioner
15 is awarded that certain real property located in the County of

6 which should be awarded to Petitioner, subject to the
7 encumbrance owing to General Motors Acceptance Corpora-
8 tion; and

9 3. Petitioner should be awarded the refrigerator, range,
10 living room sofa and chairs, and washer and dryer; and

11 4. Petitioner should be awarded all remaining
12 household furniture, fixtures, appliances, located
13 at the family residence civilly described as 5462
14 Cottage Avenue, Klamath Falls, Klamath County,
15 Oregon; and

16 5. Petitioner should be awarded her accounts in
17 Credit Union or savings accounts held in her
18 individual name; and

19 6. Petitioner should be awarded her clothing,
20 gifts, tokens, mementoes, and any other personal
21 items presently in her possession or vested in her
22 name, not specifically awarded to respondent.

23 To Respondent:

24 1. Respondent should be awarded those certain
25 furniture items located at his residence, civilly
26 described as 1331 Avalon Street, Klamath Falls,
27 Klamath County, Oregon, subject to any encumbrance
28 owing thereon; and

2. Respondent should be awarded his clothing, gifts,
tokens, and mementoes, presently in his possession.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the
obligations of the parties are ordered to be paid by the
parties as follows:

To be Paid by Petitioner:

1. Finance One Visa in the approximate amount of
\$1,127.85.

To be Paid by Respondent:

1. Department of Internal Revenue Service in the
approximate amount of \$300.00.

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1 2. Merle West Medical Center in the approximate
2 amount of \$9,600.00

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
4 Respondent is ordered to make a contribution toward
5 Petitioner's reasonable attorney's fees herein in the sum
6 of \$350.00, together with her costs herein in the sum of
7 \$119.00; and Petitioner's attorney, NEAL G. BUCHANAN, is
8 awarded judgment as against Respondent for said reasonable
9 attorney's fees and costs in accordance with ORS 107.445
10 in the said sums.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that each of
12 the parties shall be required to pay their individually
13 incurred obligations, incurred by either of the parties
14 after their separation on or about the 1st day of April,
15 1985.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that,
17 pursuant to law, the relevant data sheet attached hereto
18 as Exhibit "A" is incorporated by reference and made a
19 part of this Decree.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that each
21 of the parties herein shall notify the Clerk of the Court
22 in writing of any change of the home or business address
23 of that person within ten days after such change in accordance
24 with ORS 23.775.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
26 NEAL G. BUCHANAN is discharged as attorney of record herein.
