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LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned:

IRENE ALICE STOLLAR
1038 Anderson Way
San Gabriel, California 91776

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herein called the "principal", hereby constitutes and appoints:

JOHN F. STOLLAR and WILLIAM G. STOLLAR, acting
together or either of them acting alone,

the principal's true and lawful Attorney in Fact.

1. Authorization to Act in Principal's Behalf.

Said Attorney in Fact is hereby authorized and
empowered for and in the principal's name, place and stead:

(a) Purchase of Bonds

To purchase for the principal's sole account
United States of America treasury bonds of the kind which are
redeemable at par in payment of federal estate taxes, to borrow
money and obtain credit in the principal's name from any source
for such purpose and in connection therewith, to make, execute,
endorse, and deliver any and all necessary or desirable
promissory notes, bills of exchange, drafts, agreements, or other
obligations and, as security therefor, to pledge, mortgage, and
assign any stocks, bonds, insurance values, securities, or other
properties (real, personal, or mixed) which the principal may own
or in which the principal may have an interest, and to arrange
for the safekeeping and custody of such treasury bonds.

(b) Tax Matters

To make, verify and file federal, state, or local
income, gift, or other tax returns of all kinds, claims for
refund, requests for extensions of time, petitions to the tax
court or other courts regarding tax matters, or any and all other
tax related documents, including receipts, offers, waivers,
consents, powers of attorney and closing agreements of all kinds
without limit, and generally to act in behalf of the principal in
all tax matters for all periods before all officers of the
Internal Revenue Service or any other taxing authority, including
receipt of confidential information, and to cause the principal
to be represented in any and all such proceedings.

(c) Transfer to Trust

To transfer and convey to the Trustee or Trustees
then acting under a certain Inter Vivos Trust Agreement,

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heretofore executed on October 22, 1984 by the principal as settlor and by

JOHN F. STOLLAR and WILLIAM G. STOLLAR

as the initial Trustees, known as the:

IRENE A. STOLLAR LIVING TRUST

any or all assets now or at any time or times hereafter standing in the principal's name (or representing the principal's interest in assets owned jointly, commonly, or otherwise with any other person or persons), including without limitation real estate, ownership rights in insurance policies of all kinds, cash, checks (including government and insurance checks), stocks, bonds (including any purchased under paragraph (a) above), securities, or other properties of all kinds, and, pursuant to such purpose, to terminate savings, checking, safekeeping, agency, investment advisory, and custody accounts in the principal's name (alone or with others) and safe deposit boxes, at any bank or broker by directing that all or any part of the balance therein, including all cash, stocks, bonds, securities, or other properties of all kinds (subject to any indebtedness secured thereby), be transferred and delivered to said trustee or trustees.

(d) Enabling Powers

With respect to any of the foregoing acts, to do and perform every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises as fully to all intents and purposes as the principal might or could do if personally present, including without limitation, authority to enter into oral or written agreements and to execute, acknowledge, and deliver any stock power, deed, or other written instrument of any kind.

2. Ratification

The principal hereby ratifies and confirms all that each said attorney in fact shall do or cause to be done by virtue hereof and all documents of any kind, without limitation, executed or delivered by said attorneys (or any one of them) shall bind the principal and the principal's heirs, distributees, legal representatives, successors and assigns.

3. Inducement

For the purpose of inducing any bank, broker, custodian, insurer, lender, transfer agent, or other party to act in accordance with the powers granted in this power of attorney, the principal hereby represents, warrants, and agrees that, if this power of attorney is terminated for any reason whatsoever, the principal and the principal's heirs, distributees, legal representatives, successors, and assigns will save such party or parties harmless from any loss suffered or liability incurred by

such party or parties in acting in accordance with this power of attorney prior to such party's receipt of written notice of any such termination.

4. Durability (C.C. 2400 <a>)

This power of attorney shall ^{NOT BE AFFECTED BY SUBSEQUENT} become effective upon the incapacity of the principal. *I.A.S.*

5. Governing Law

This power of attorney shall be governed by the laws of the State of California in all respects, including its validity, construction, interpretation, and termination. Should any provision hereof be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.

6. Copies Valid as Originals

Any copy of this Power of Attorney, however reproduced, shall be as valid as the original, and may be relied upon by anyone dealing with the Attorney in Fact.

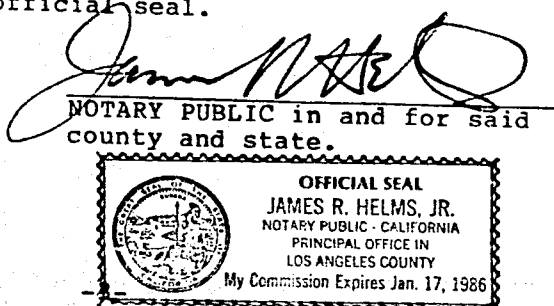
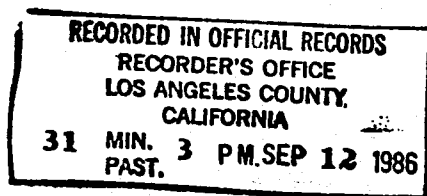
