The Planning Commission, after reviewing the evidence, made the following decision: 18 19 FINDINGS OF FACT: 20 The property in question is located in Section 19 of 21 Township 25, Range 8, Klamath County, Oregon. 22 2. The applicant requested a variance from the provisions 23 of Section 71.022 and Section 71.010, i.e., a variance for set-24 backs as they occur, block length, and a variance on road 25 standards for existing roads within existing subdivision. Subdivision roads to be improved with native material with adequate drainage and the road is to be 16 feet wide. 4. The difficulty or hardship arises from the property's

topography and shape and improvements which result in a greater 1 private expense than public benefit of strict enforcement. 2

3 The condition causing the difficulty was not created by 5. the applicant. 4

6. The granting of the variance will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, and welfare or to the use and enjoyment 6 of adjacent properties and will not be contrary to the intent of 7 8 this Code.

9 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

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This request for a variance on the subject property 1. 11 meets the applicable Klamath County Development Code criteria 12 and policies governing such. 13

2. This request for a variance is consistent with, and 14 complies with, all applicable Statewide Planning Goals and Review 15 Criteria.
