All that portion of Section 12, Township 41 South, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 16 feet West of a point 1317.36 feet West of the North quarter corner of Section 12, Township 41 South, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence West 120 feet to the Northeast corner of Book 176 at page 513, Deed Records, recorded May 29, 1945; thence South to Lost River; thence Southeasterly following the North bank of Lost River to a point due South of the point of beginning; thence North to the point of beginning.

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PARCEL 1:

That portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 38 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, (being a part of Government Lots 1 and 5), lying East of the New Dalles-California Highway, in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:
