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# Notice of Mining Location VEIN OR LOSE CLAIM

STATE OF OREGON,

County of Klamath

Scott Creek

Mining District

THIS DIAGRAM EXPLAINS METHOD OF DESCRIPTION OF CLAIM.

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a vein or lode of locatable mineral bearing rock in place upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Oregon, have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post or monument at the point of discovery, marked Post No. 1. The name of the claim is:

Flower #3

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 (Discovery Post), thence

128 feet in a S 54° E direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence  
300 feet in a N 36° E direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence  
1500 feet in a N 54° W direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence  
300 feet in a S 36° W direction to an end post marked No. 5, thence  
300 feet in a S 36° W direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence  
1500 feet in a S 54° E direction to a corner post marked No. 7, thence  
300 feet in a N 36° E direction to said end post marked No. 2.

The locators claim 128 feet in a Southeast end line and 1372' feet in the opposite direction from point of discovery to the Northwest end line and

300 feet on each side of the middle of said vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 128 feet from a natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity, to-wit:

The general course or strike of the vein or lode as nearly as may be determined is N 54° W

This claim is situated in the SW 1/4 with reference to the natural object or permanent monument described above, Range 7 1/2 E, of the Willamette Meridian, as surveyed by the U.S. Government

The end lines of the claim are parallel to each other. The adjoining claims are Flower #2 on the SW side, Flower #4 on the NE side, Flower #8 on the SE end

This notice is placed conspicuously at discovery post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner and both center ends.

The location of this claim is distinctly marked on the ground so that the boundaries of the claim may be readily traced.

In construing this location notice, the singular includes the plural and vice versa, where the context so requires.
