Notice of Location of Placer Claim

(2) If claim is on unsurveyed land or if on surveyed land and it is not practicable to describe the claim by legal subdivisions:

The distance between posts may not exceed 1320 feet. The number of posts will vary depending on the size of the claim.

This claim is situated in the _____ (quarter section) of Section _____, Township _____, Range _____, of the _____ Meridian, either as surveyed by the U.S. Government or protracted if the land is unsurveyed.
