Klamath County Planning Findings of Fact and Order

6 A hearing was held on this matter on December 18, 1986, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 45.2, 7 Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Carl Shuck and Kim Lundahl. The Hearings Reporter was Janet Libercajt. Both applicant and representative were present.

12 Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were no adjacent property owners present.

submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Conclusions of Law:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. The proposed use is conditionally permitted in the zone

within which it is proposed to be located.

2. The location, size, design, and operating characteristics of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan.

- 3. The location, size, design, and operating characteristics of the proposed use will be compatible with and will not have a significant adverse affect on the appropriate development and use of abutting property and the surrounding neighborhood.
- The granting of this conditional use permit is consistent with the goals of the Land Conservation and Development Commission.
- This conditional use permit is granted subject to the 5. following conditions:
 - (a) Operation of the model railroad system is to be noncommercial and non-profit.
 - (b) Development of accessory buildings and use require site plan approval by the Klamath County Planning Director prior to the commencement of operations.
 - (c) There shall be a review in one (1) year to determine if the conditional use permit is operating without problems.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

This request has been granted conditionally based on the following findings of fact:

- The applicant requests a conditional use permit under Section 51.018(C)(6) of the Klamath County Land Development Code, and seeks to add 137 acres to a 200 acre park site already developed southwest of Chiloquin.
- This park is to be devoted to and used by hobbyists who would build, operate and maintain a 1/8 scale model railroad. An C.U.P. 46-86/Gienger Enterprises, Inc.

adjacent property owner operates a small model railroad system on property to the south, and the proposed expansion will tie into this system. The intensity of the use, following construction, will be minimal and non-commercial.

- The project site is zoned EFU-CG (Exclusive Farm Use-Cropland, Grazing). State and local Goal 3 require this property to be preserved for agricultural use. However, staff feels that the intensity and type of use requested would not preclude its use for livestock grazing, and therefore recommends the approval of this request.
- Notice of this hearing was sent to the surrounding 12 property owners, to concerned public agencies, and published in the Herald and News, the Klamath Falls newspaper.
 - 5. No one testified in opposition to the granting of this permit and no evidence was presented that there would be any adverse affects to the abutting property or to the surrounding area by the granting of this permit.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as

"Being generally located on a Portion of the W 1/2, Section 4 Township 35 South, Range 7 East, north of Highway 422, and more particularly described as Lots 14, 15, 23, 24, 25, and the W 1/2 of Lots 16, 22, 32, and 35 of Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 7 East, Klamath County, Oregon,"
