The location, size, design, and operating characteristics 28 of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath County

Comprehensive Plan.

3. The location, size, design, and operating characteristics 2 of the proposed use will be compatible with and will not have a 3 significant adverse affect on the appropriate development and use of abutting property and the surrounding neighborhood.

4. The granting of this conditional use permit is consisten with the goals of the Land Conservation and Development Commission. FINDINGS OF FACT:

This request has been granted based on the following findings of fact: 1.

This is a request for a conditional use permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages at an eating and drinking establishment. The applicant, in addition to providing athletic facilities, provides food and beverages for its members. Testimony from a representative of the applicant was that any use of alcoholic beverages would be incidental to the use of the athletic facilities.

2. The property is zoned CG (General Commercial). has access to Washburn Way off Crosby Street. It appears that Crosby Street can handle the traffic that would be generated from the proposed use.

3. Notice of this hearing was sent to the surrounding property owners, to concerned public agencies, and published in the <u>Herald and News</u>, the Klamath Falls newspaper.
