liens At Law Supersede Mortgages and Equity Liens, <u>Drummond Carriage Co. V. Mills.</u> (1898) 74 N.W.966; Hewitt V. Williams. 47 La. Ann. 742, 17 So. 269; <u>Car V. Dail.</u> 19 S.E. 235; <u>McMahon V. Lundin.</u> 58 N.W. 827, and may be satisfied only when a court of Common Law is called to convene pursuant to order of the elected sheriff under Amendment 7 of the Bill of Bights Court Convene Amendment 7 of the Bill of Rights. Such Common Law Court forbids the presence of any judge or lawyer participating or presiding or the practice of any Equity Law.
