

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, JAMES M. NELSON, DO hereby certify that

have made, constituted and appointed and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint

my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead and for my use and benefit,

(1) To lease, let, grant, bargain, sell, contract to sell, convey, exchange, remove, release and dispose of any real or personal property of which I am now or hereafter may be possessed or in which I may have any right, title or interest, including rights of husband and wife, and any other or such other and conditions as to my said attorney may seem proper.

(2) To take possession of, manage, maintain, operate, repair and improve any and all real or personal property now or hereafter belonging to me, to pay the expenses thereof, to insure and keep the same insured and to pay any and all taxes, charges and assessments that may be levied or imposed upon any thereof.

(3) To buy, sell and generally deal in and with goods, wares and merchandise of every name, nature and description and to hypothecate, pledge and encumber the same.

(4) To buy, sell, assign, transfer and deliver all or any shares of stock in any name in any corporation for any price and upon such terms as to my said attorney may seem right and proper and to receive and make payment therefor.

(5) To borrow any sums of money on such terms and at such rate of interest as to my said attorney may seem proper and to give security for the repayment of the same.

(6) To act for, demand, receive, collect and recover all moneys, debts, rents, dues, accounts, legacies, bequests, interest, dividends and claims whatsoever which are now or shall hereafter may become due, owing and payable or belonging to me and to have, use and take all lawful ways and means in my name for the recovery of any thereof by attachment, law or otherwise.

(7) To prepare, execute and file any deed or other instruments in any court and to take any proceedings under the Statutory Act in connection with any sum of money or demand due or payable to me and to any such proceedings to take in my name for the collection of any debts or claims and to demand, receive and accept any dividend or distribution whatsoever.

(8) To adjust, settle, compromise or submit to arbitration any account, debt, claim, demand or dispute as well as matters which are now subsisting or hereafter may arise between me or my said attorney and any other person or persons.

(9) To sell, discount, endorse, negotiate and deliver any check, draft, order, bill of exchange, promissory note or other negotiable paper payable to me, and to collect, receive and apply the proceeds thereof for my use for any of the purposes aforesaid, to pay to or beyond the same or any other sum of money coming into the hands of my attorney in checking and in savings accounts in my name with any bank or banker of my attorney's selection and to draw out moneys deposited in my credit with any bank, including deposits in savings accounts, and to apply the same for any of the purposes of my business as my said attorney may deem expedient, to purchase and sell certificates of deposit, to appoint any bank or trust company as escrow agent, generally to conduct any and all banking transactions in my behalf.

(10) To make, execute and deliver any and all manner of contracts with reference to purchase, sale, lease, and for rights, notes and royalties, including agreements facilitating exploration for and discovery of oil, gas, coal and deposits.

(11) To commence and prosecute and to defend against, answer and oppose all actions, suits and proceedings touching any of the matters aforesaid or any other matters in which I am or hereafter may be interested or concerned.

(12) To take any stock in my name as proxy.

(13) To have access to any safety deposit box which has been or may be rented in my name or in the name of myself and any other person or persons.

(14) In connection with any of the powers herein granted, to sign, make, execute, acknowledge and file in my name any and all deeds, contracts, bills of sale, leases, promissory notes, drafts, assignments, releases of debt, obligations, mortgages, pledges, indentures, releases, quitclaims, receipts, bonds, notes and any and all other instruments whatsoever, with such general or special agreements and covenants, including those of warranty, as to my said attorney may seem right, proper and expedient.

(15) To employ, pay and discharge clerks, workmen, brokers and others, including counsel and attorneys in connection with the exercise of any of the foregoing powers.

(17) Generally to conduct, manage and control all my business and my property, whatsoever estate, as my said attorney may deem for my best interests, hereby releasing all third persons from responsibility for the acts and omissions of my said attorney.

I hereby give and grant unto my said attorney full power and authority hereby to do and perform every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do if personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney-in-fact shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof. The powers of my said attorney shall be exercisable by him or herself or by any one or more of his or her associates or assistants.

In executing this power of attorney, it is to be understood that the undersigned may be more than one person or a corporation and that, therefore, if the context so requires, the singular pronoun shall be taken to mean and include the plural, the masculine, the feminine and the neuter and that generally all grammatical changes shall be made, assumed and implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and to more than one individual.

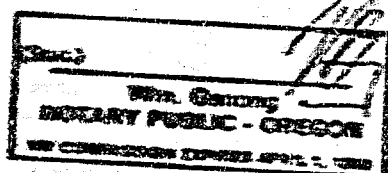
