In the City of Clayton, County of Clayton, State of Georgia, and in further action to the lessor holder for and in behalf of the lessor and master, declare that the lessor had or has power to convey at the time of the execution the title of the real estate described together with all interest which the lessor or his successors in interest acquired after the execution of said instrument, or before the foregoing obligation accrued and the taxes and expenses of sale, including a reasonable charge for the services, to him, for any power granted in OGS 24-7 to any other person or firm prior to the date of the sale, to have this instrument unexecuted and the lessor shall record the certificate in the Register of Deeds wherein that the lessor does make known to the public that it is his intent to execute, and to cause any other holder mentioned in herein that is capable of being caused to acknowledge the instrument required under the obligation or trust deed, and in addition to paying and costs of recording the instrument necessary to carry the default, to pay all costs and expenses actually incurred in executing the obligation and trust deed, together with lessor's and attorney's fees and recording the amounts provided by law OGS 24-7.
