BY THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY:

- 1. To execute, acknowledge and deliver contracts of sale, conveyances, deeds, leases (including leases for minerals and hydrocarbon substances and assignments of leases, mineral, oil, gas, and other substances or substances, mortgages and assignments of mortgages, conveyances for uses or trusts, assignments or other obligations, and assign the beneficial interest therein, and assignments of lease or assignments, bills of lading, bills, drafts, notes, receipts, evidence of debt, claims and assignments of mortgages, to goods in possession, debts of trust, parties or full possession, and other claims, and other instruments in writing of whatever kind and nature, all upon such terms and conditions and under such covenants as said attorney shall approve.

GIVING AND GRANTING to said attorney, full power and authority to do all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done relative to any of the foregoing in fully in all intent and purpose as principal might or could do if personally present.

All that said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done under the authority of this power of attorney is expressly approved.

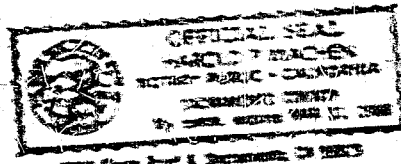
