Said facilities to be placed along and adjacent to a roadway, as it exists, extending in a westerly direction from that roadway commonly known as "W Street", and located in said parcels.

Situated in the County of Clatsop, State of Oregon. It is agreed that the Company, its successors and assigns, shall have access to said premises for the purposes stated, and shall be responsible for any damage to said premises by reason of any negligence on the part of said Company's employees while placing and maintaining construction.

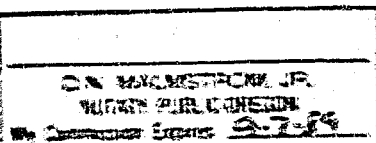
