This question also requires to take into account the contribution for those who do not receive 100% of the pay rate of wages, giving out a chance to get to contribute more to the pension fund to encourage. In the case of those who receive less than 100% of their compensation, there will be some difficulty in the application of the same plan, so the members of the pension fund will have to apply for a reduction in the amount of the contributions for pension and contributions to a sum of money determined by the amount of the pension, which is the sum of the contributions of the members to the pension fund.
