4. SPECIAL PROVISIONS AND LIMITATIONS. In exercising the authority under this power of attorney, my agent is subject to the following special provisions and limitations: None.

5. EXERCISE OF POWER OF ATTORNEY WHERE MORE THAN ONE AGENT DESIGNATED. If I have designated more than one agent, the agents are to act independently.

6. DURATION. This power of attorney expires on 8-30-87.

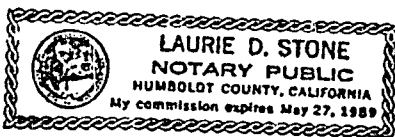
