The STATE OF OREGON, acting by and through the Division of State Lands, GRANTOR, for and in consideration of Two Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Two and no dollars (\$ 2,122.00), does hereby grant to Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division, GRANTEE, an easement, and right to construct, maintain, operate, and replace a bridge in, over, and across state-owned submerged follows:

A parcel of land lying in the NE1/4 of Section 21, Township 35 South, Range 7 East, W.M., Klamath County, Oregon; the said parcel being all state-owned mean high water on the Northerly and Southerly banks of the Williamson River and included in a strip of land variable in width, lying on the Westerly side of the center line of the relocated The Dallas-California Highway which center line is described as follows:

Beginning at Engineer's center line Station 1150+00, said station being 2749.19 feet South and 213.39 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 33, Township 35 South, Range 7 East, W.M.; thence, North 9°32' West 12,465.19 feet to Engineer's center line Station 1274+65.19.
