**CLAIM OF LIEN
FARM LABOR, SERVICES,

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That Carl Rajnus
claims a lien upon the crops of grain and hay
and the following described animals none

grown in the year 1987 upon the following described farmland, range, ranch, orchard land or in claimant's place
of business situated in Klamath County, Oregon, to-wit:

Section 12: That portion of the SW 1/4 lying Westerly of new Poe Valley-
Malin Highway and Southerly of Schaupp Road as the same is now located and
constructed.

Section 13: The W 1/2, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the East 120 feet of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4; that
portion of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 and the W 1/2 SE 1/4 lying Westerly of the new Poe Valley-Malin
Highway as the same is now located and constructed.

Section 14: The E 1/2 NE 1/4 and the E 1/2 SE 1/4.

Said lien also is claimed upon the proceeds of the sale of any or all of said crops and animals and upon the unborn
progeny of said animals which are in utero on the date of the filing of this claim of lien. For brevity, the crops and/or
animals and/or their said unborn progeny charged with this lien hereinafter are called chattels.

Said lien is claimed for labor performed, materials supplied and/or services provided (as hereinafter more par-
ticularly described) by claimant at the request and for the benefit of the owner of said chattels to aid the growing or
harvesting of crops and for the raising of livestock upon the land described above; the words "performs labor or pro-
vides services," "materials," "growing and harvesting" and "raising animals" as used in this lien have the meaning
ascribed to them in ORS 87226(3), to which reference hereby is made.

The said labor, materials and/or services consisted of tillage, planting, irrigating,
application of fertilizers and chemicals, spraying, weed control, fence work.

The name of the owner of the chattels so charged with this lien is Dan Rajnus



The foregoing lien is authorized by ORS 87.226 (1). ORS 87.242 provides in part: (1) A person claiming a lien created by ORS 87.226 shall file a written notice of claim of lien with the recording officer of the county in which the debtor resides, or, if the lien debtor is a business, the county in which the lien debtor has its principal place of business not later than 75 days after the close of the furnishing of the labor, services or materials. ORS 87.246 provides: "The recording officer of the county shall record the notices filed under ORS 87.242 in a book kept for that purpose and called 'index of liens upon chattels.'" (1) When a lien claimant files a notice of claim of lien as required by ORS 87.242, the lien claimant shall send forthwith a copy of the notice to the owner of the chattel to be charged with the lien by registered or certified mail sent to the owner at the owner's last known address. (2) When a lien claimant files a notice of claim of lien as required by ORS 87.242, the lien claimant shall send a copy of the notice to all holders of security interests in the chattel to be charged with the lien who duly perfected such security interests by filing notice thereof with the Secretary of State. The notice shall be mailed to holders of perfected security interests within 20 days after the date of filing. (3) No costs, disbursements or attorney fees otherwise allowable as provided by ORS 87.336 shall be allowed to any party failing to comply with subsections (1) and (2) of this section."
