Restrictive Covenant

Declaration:

Wire mesh or chain link (cyclone) fencing may be placed on the upper elevation for security purposes and/or for the containment of domestic animals. Decorative wooden fencing is also permitted.

An easement sixty feet in width is created on, and adjacent to the west boundary of each parcel, designated Marsha Way, for mutual roadway and all roadway purposes, and for the placement of public utilities.
