KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That KENO OPEN BIBLE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC., a non-profit corporation

hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, to grantor paid by JOHN GORDON LESLIE and SHERRY MARLENE LESLIE, hereinafter called the grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Nine (9) in Block Five (5) of the town of DOTEN, according to the duly recorded plat thereof.

grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.
