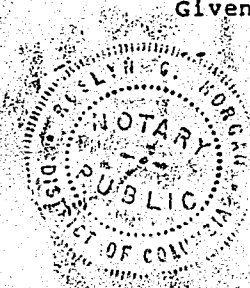

On or about May 1960, I was assigned to the position of Assistant Director of Housing, and during my tenure in that position, I was responsible for the administration of the National Housing Act, as amended, and the Federal Housing Administration.

I am advised by [redacted] that Robert G. Smith, a former employee of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, was employed by the Federal Housing Administration from approximately 1958 to 1960. During his employment, he was assigned to the position of Assistant Director of Housing, and was responsible for the administration of the National Housing Act, as amended, and the Federal Housing Administration.

[redacted] further advised that Robert G. Smith was known to me at the time of my appointment to the position of Assistant Director of Housing, and that he appeared before me for an interview on or about May 1960.
