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This matter came before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, 4 William M. Ganong, on January 7, 1988, and on January 22, 1988, 5 the Conditional Use Permit to allow two large animals was denied. 6 The applicant appealed the Hearings Officer decision on 7 January 29, 1988, to the Board of Commissioners, and on March 1, 8 1988, the Board of Commissioners overturned the decision of the 9 Hearings Officer and approved Conditional Use Permit 50-87 based 10 on additional evidence presented and makes the following Findings 11 of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and decision: 12

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

KLAMATH COUNTY, OREGON

FINDINGS OF FACT:

14 The applicants own the property described as Klamath 1. 15 County Tax Assessor's Lot No. 3909-3DB-4500. Said lot contains 16 approximately 10,400 square feet. The subject property has been 17 rented for approximately three years to Cindy Hurt. Ms. Hurt can 18 place one large animal on subject lot.

19 2. The subject property is fenced and horses have been 20 pastured on the property from time to time in the past.

21 The subject property is zoned RS, Suburban Residential. 3. 22 Approximately three-fourths of the subject property is available 23 for use by the one horse.

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KLAMATH COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE CRITERIA:

25 Land Development Code Section 51.005(C) provides that not 26 more than four large animals per acre may be permitted in the RS 27 zone by Conditional Use Permit. 28

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3951 KLAMATH COUNTY CODE FINDINGS FACT AND CONCLUSION: 1 Pursuant to Code Section 44.003 the following findings and 2 conclusions are made: 3 4 1. The proposed use is conditionally permitted in the zone in which it is proposed to be located. Horses (ponies) are 5 defined as "large animals" by the Land Use Code. Depending on 6 the lot size and the number of animals, large animals are per-7 mitted outright or by Conditional Use Permit in the RS zone. 8 9 2. The size of the lot for the proposed use is 10,400 square feet which requires a Conditional Use Permit when parcel is under 10 20,000 square feet. The Board of Commissioners find that one 11 12 horse meets the criteria as spelled out in Land Development Code Section 51.005(C) (see above). 14 This application for Conditional Use Permit 50-87 to keep large animals on property described as being located in Section 15 16 3DB of Township 39S, Range 9EWM, Tax Lot 4500, is approved, subject to only one horse being permitted on subject property 17 18 as described above.
