Such insurance shall be in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any co-insurance clause. Insurance shall be made with loss payable to Seller and Buyer, as their respective interests may appear. In the event of loss, Buyer shall give emmediate notice to Seller. Seller may make proof of loss if Buyer fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the loss. If Buyer fails to keep insurance in force, Seller may obtain insurance, and add the cost to the balance due on the Contract. The insurance cost shall be payable to Seller on demand.
