3 I. NATURE OF REQUEST

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A public hearing was held on this application April 26, 1988, before the Klamath County Planning Commission. The request for 5 a Variance from the 1,000 foot maximum length for a cul-de-sac 6 allowed per Land Development Code Section 71.014 to the 1,140 feet 7 proposed by preliminary Tract 1255 was considered pursuant to 8 9 Article 43 of the Land Development Code.

10 II. NAMES OF THOSE INVOLVED

The applicant, K. Mark Jungnitsch was present and represented 12 by Jack Ramey. No other parties appeared in support or in opposi-13 tion to this request. That the granting of the Variance will not be detrimental 7 to the public health, safety, and welfare or to the use с. and enjoyment of adjacent properties and will not be 8 contrary to the intent of this Code. 9 FINDINGS 10 VI. The Planning Commission found, by unanimous vote of all pre-11 12 sent, the evidence submitted and testimony offered demonstrate the approval criteria as set out in Section V have been satisfied. 13 14 VII. CONCLUSIONS This application has satisfied the review criteria in that 15 16 Correct notice was given, all relevant Comprehensive Plan Policies and review criteria have been complied with. 17 18 VIII.
