That blasting which may be necessary will not damage existing structures or facilities. and those set out in Land Development Code Section 51.019(C): Does not interfere seriously with accepted farming a. practices on adjacent lands; Wherever possible, use will be situated upon land b. generally unsuitable for farm use as defined by this Code, considering parcel size, the terrain, vegetation, drainage, adverse soil conditions, flooding and location; Wherever possible, use will not be located upon soils c. classified predominantly as I-IV; The access shall be designed so as not to interfere d. with accepted farm practices on surrounding land; and Complies with such other conditions as the review e. authority considers necessary. VI. FINDINGS The Planning Commission found, by a vote of five to one, the evidence submitted and testimony offered demonstrate the approval criteria, as set out in Section V have been satisfied. VII. CONCLUSIONS This application has satisfied the criteria in that correct notice was given, all relevant Comprehensive Plan Policies and review criteria have been complied with.
