THIS MATTER came on for trial on July 2, 1976.

Petitioner appeared in person and by Dennis A. Hachler, her attorney. Respondent did not appear and was found in default.

The court finding that irreconcilable differences exist between the parties, making continuation of the marriage relationship impossible, and that the parties were married on December 7, 1973, at Pendleton, Oregon, and that one child was born of the marriage, namely: CLINT JUSTIN PACE, a boy, born April 4, 1974.

IT IS HEREBY DECREED THAT:

1. The marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved and said dissolution is finally effective September 1, 1976.

2. Petitioner is awarded custody of the minor child and respondent shall have reasonable visitation of him.

3. Respondent shall pay each month, commencing

1 July 5, 1976, the sum of \$75.00 as a contribution
2 to the support of said minor child. These payments shall
3 continue with respect to said child until further order of
4 the court or the child attains the age of majority, dies,
5 marries, or otherwise becomes emancipated, whichever shall
6 first occur.

7 4. All support payments herein ordered shall be made
8 through the Department of Human Resources, Support Manage-
9 ment Unit, 400 Public Service Building, P. O. Box 2506,
10 Salem, Oregon 97308.

11 5. Respondent shall provide medical and hospitalization
12 insurance, through his place of employment, covering the
13 minor child of the parties.

14 6. Respondent shall assume and pay and hold petitioner
15 harmless from the household indebtedness payable to Pendleton
16 Community Hospital, Sears, Roebuck & Co., both Pendleton,
17 Oregon.

18 7. Petitioner shall assume and pay and hold respondent
19 harmless from one-half of the existing indebtedness payable to
20 Harris Pine Credit Union, Pendleton, Oregon, which debt is
21 secured by the 1972 Toyota 2-door sedan automobile herein-
22 after awarded to petitioner.

23 8. Respondent shall assume and pay and hold petitioner
24 harmless from one-half of the existing indebtedness payable to
25 Harris Pine Credit Union, Pendleton, Oregon, which debt is

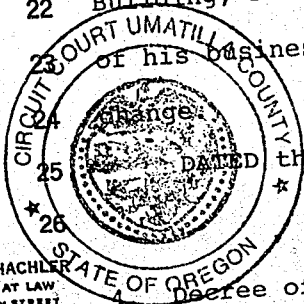
