 15 a Stipulation to Reopen, and for entry of an Amended Judgment and
 16 Decree of Dissolution of Marriage herein, and good cause
 17 appearing therefore, and the Court being fully advised in the
 18 premises, now therefore

19 1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the
 20 marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved and said dissolution
 21 is finally effective on the 23rd day of June, 1979.

22 2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Co-Petitioner, Winifred Ann DeWitt, be and hereby is awarded custody, care and control of the minor children of the parties, Wade Allen DeWitt and Eric John DeWitt, subject to the right of Co-Petitioner, husband Walter Allen DeWitt, to see and visit said children at such times and places as will not interfere with their health, education and welfare.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Co-Petitioner, husband Walter Allen DeWitt, be and he hereby is ordered to contribute the sum of ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100THS DOLLARS (\$100.00) per month, per child, or a total of TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100THS DOLLARS (\$200.00) per month, as and for child support for said minor children until said children attain the age of 18 years, married, or otherwise emancipated, or are no longer children "attending school" under the provisions of ORS 108.110 (2) (as in effect in 1979).

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the real property known as 4129 Barry Drive, Klamath Falls, Oregon, and legally described as follows, to-wit:

"Lot 4 in Block 10 of Tract No. 1026, The Meadows, according to the official plat thereof on file in the Office of the County clerk of Klamath County, Oregon."

shall be vested in Co-Petitioner, Winifred Ann DeWitt, subject to the encumbrances thereon, which Co-Petitioner, Winifred Ann DeWitt, shall be required to pay, and to hold Co-Petitioner, Walter Allen DeWitt, harmless therefrom.

11 personal property, free of any interest of Co-Petitioner
12 husband, Walter Allen DeWitt:

13 a) That certain 1977 Datsun 810 automobile, which
14 said automobile is subject to an encumbrance which Co-Petitioner
15 wife is required and ordered to pay, holding Co-Petitioner
16 husband harmless therefrom.

17 b) Her personal effects, gifts, tokens and mementos.

18 8. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the
19 household furniture, fixtures and appliances are to be divided
20 equally between the parties.

21 9. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
22 Co-Petitioner, husband, Walter Allen DeWitt, is hereby awarded
23 the dependent deduction of said minor children on his State and
24 Federal income tax returns for the year 1979 and each year
25 thereafter, so long as his child support payments are current on
26 the last day of that year.

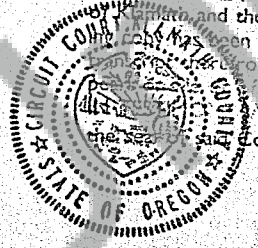
