 JUDGMENT AND DECREE OF

THIS MATTER came on for a hearing on the 23rd day of April, 1979. Co-Petitioners, Walter Allen DeWitt and Winifred Ann DeWitt, appearing by and through their attorney, Blair M. Henderson; and the Court finding that irreconcilable differences exist between the parties make continuation of the marriage relationship impossible; and the Court having thereafter received a Stipulation to Reopen, and for entry of an Amended Judgment and Decree of Dissolution of Marriage herein, and good cause appearing therefore, and the Court being fully advised in the premises, now therefore

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved and said dissolution is finally effective on the 23rd day of June, 1979.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the relevant data is as follows:

2 3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
3 Co-Petitioner, Winifred Ann DeWitt, be and hereby is awarded
4 custody, care and control of the minor children of the parties,
5 Wade Allen DeWitt and Eric John DeWitt, subject to the right of
6 Co-Petitioner, husband Walter Allen DeWitt, to see and visit said
7 children at such times and places as will not interfere with
8 their health, education and welfare.

9 4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
10 Co-Petitioner, husband Walter Allen DeWitt, be and he hereby is
11 ordered to contribute the sum of ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100THS
12 DOLLARS (\$100.00) per month, per child, or a total of TWO HUNDRED
13 AND NO/100THS DOLLARS (\$200.00) per month, as and for child
14 support for said minor children until said children attain the
15 age of 18 years, married, or otherwise emancipated, or are no
16 longer children "attending school" under the provisions of ORS
17 108.110 (2) (as in effect in 1979).

18 5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the
19 real property known as 4129 Barry Drive, Klamath Falls, Oregon,
20 and legally described as follows, to-wit:

21 "Lot 4 in Block 10 of Tract No. 1026, The Meadows,
22 according to the official plat thereof on file in the
23 Office of the County clerk of Klamath County,
24 Oregon."

25 shall be vested in Co-Petitioner, Winifred Ann DeWitt, subject to
26 the encumbrances thereon, which Co-Petitioner, Winifred Ann
27 DeWitt, shall be required to pay, and to hold Co-Petitioner,
28 Walter Allen DeWitt, harmless therefrom.

9 7. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
10 Co-Petitioner, Winifred Ann DeWitt, is awarded the following
11 personal property, free of any interest of Co-Petitioner
12 husband, Walter Allen DeWitt:

13 a) That certain 1977 Datsun 810 automobile, which
14 said automobile is subject to an encumbrance which Co-Petitioner
15 wife is required and ordered to pay, holding Co-Petitioner
16 husband harmless therefrom.

17 b) Her personal effects, gifts, tokens and mementos.

18 8. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the
19 household furniture, fixtures and appliances are to be divided
20 equally between the parties.

21 9. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
22 Co-Petitioner, husband, Walter Allen DeWitt, is hereby awarded
23 the dependent deduction of said minor children on his State and
24 Federal income tax returns for the year 1979 and each year
25 thereafter, so long as his child support payments are current on
26 the last day of that year.
