This matter came before the Klamath County Special Hearings Officer, Susan Crismon, on September 15, 1988, and on September 21, 1988, an order was issued denying a Conditional Use Permit allowing two large animals to be maintained on a lot less than 20,000

square feet in area in the RS (Suburban Residential) zone.

The applicant, Eudora Whitaker, appealed the Hearings Officer decision on September 23, 1988, to the Board of County Commissioners and at hearing on October 26, 1988, the decision of the Hearings Officer was partially overturned and approved Conditional Use Permit 12-88 to conditionally allow the maintenance of one large

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The applicants own the property described as Klamath 1. County Tax Assessor's Lot No. 3909-3DB-4600. Said lot contains 17,860 square feet.
- The subject property is fenced and horses have been pastured on the property in the past. Approximately two-thirds of the subject property is available for pasturage.
- The subject property is zoned RS, Suburban Residential. KLAMATH COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE CRITERIA:

Land Development Code Section 51.005(C) provides that large animals may be maintained at a ratio of four per acre, but none on lots smaller than 20,000 square feet without an approved Conditional Use Permit. 111

Pursuant to Code Section 44.003, the following Conclusions of Law are made:

- The proposed use is conditionally permitted in the zone in which it is proposed to be located. Horses are defined as "large animals" by the Code. Depending on the lot size and the number of animals, large animals are permitted outright or by Conditional Use Permit in the RS zone.
- 2. The size of the lot for the proposed use is 17,860 square feet. The Board of County Commissioners finds the maintaining of one large animal on this parcel meets the criteria set out in Land Development Code Section 51.005(C). ORDER:

This application for Conditional Use Permit 12-88 to maintain large animals on property located at 2504 Crest Street is approved subject to the following:

- 1. Permit is limited to the keeping of one large animal.
- Permit to be in effect only as long as reciprocal "open gate" agreement is maintained by occupants of properties known as 2504 Crest Street, 2504 $\frac{1}{2}$  Crest Street, and 3704 Cannon Avenue.
