## Notice of Location of Placer Claim

STATE of OREGON, County of Klamath, Mining District.

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do locate a placer claim of 160 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the Sunago N.W. #2 (Two).

Claim, which is described as follows (fill out one of the two sections below):

(1) If claim is on surveyed land:

This claim comprises the Northwest Quarter of Section 19 (which), Township 29 South Range 5 East, of the Willamette Meridian, in the State of Oregon. (The location notice post stands just Northeast of the Southwest corner of the claim.)

The distance between posts may not exceed 1,320 feet. The number of posts will vary depending on the size of the claim.
