To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS,

THOMAS L. AND BETH E. STOUT, husband and wife,

being the owner of certain tracts of land situated and included within the limits of the Winema National Forest, Oregon, has under provisions of the Act approved March 20, 1922 (16 U.S.C. 485, 486); and the Act approved October 21, 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1716), reconveyed and relinquished the said tracts to the United States of America and has, under provisions of the said Acts, selected in lieu thereof the following tracts of land:

Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon

T. 36 S., R. 6 E.
sec. 15, lots 6, 7, and 8.

The area described contains 14.20 acres according to the official plats of the survey of the said land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management;

NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto Thomas L. and Beth E. Stout, the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said lands with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Thomas L. and Beth E. Stout, their heirs and assigns, forever;

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO THE UNITED STATES from the lands so granted:

1. A right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States (Act of August 30, 1890, 43 U.S.C. 945).
2. In accordance with the provisions of the Act of February 28, 1925 (43 Stat. 1090, 16 U.S.C. 486), all minerals, including gold, silver, copper, iron, lead, zinc, molybdenum, germanium, sulphur, coal, oil and gas, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine, and remove such deposits from the same under law.

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3. All geothermal steam and associated geothermal resources in the land so patented, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove such deposits, upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the provisions and limitations of the Act of December 24, 1970 (84 Stat. 1566).
