To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS

Klamath County, Oregon

is entitled to a Land Patent pursuant to Sec. 206 of the Act of October 21, 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1716), for the following described land:

Willamette Meridian, Oregon
T. 40 S., R. 14 E.,
Sec. 6, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

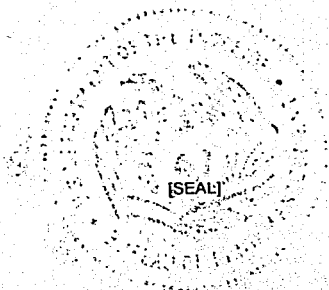
The area described contains 40.00 acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said land on file in the Bureau of Land Management;

NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Klamath County, Oregon, the land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Klamath County, Oregon, and its assigns, forever;

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO THE UNITED STATES from the lands so granted:

1. A right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States. Act of August 30, 1890 (43 U.S.C. 945);
2. A right-of-way to itself and its assigns for an exclusive easement to locate, construct, use, control, maintain, improve, relocate, and repair a road over and across the land so patented; the exact location to be determined upon mutual agreement between the grantor and grantee at a future date. The said right-of-way will be memorialized by execution of an exclusive road easement from Klamath County to the United States, in the standard Bureau of Land Management format, upon agreement as to the location of the road.

SUBJECT TO those rights for an irrigation ditch granted to the United States Bureau of Reclamation, or its assigns, by right-of-way No. OR 2085, pursuant to the Act of March 3, 1891, as amended (formerly 43 U.S.C. 946-949).
