Notice of Location of Placer Claim

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STATE of OREGON, County of Klamath

Mining District.

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared an intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do locate a placer claim of 160 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the M.G.S.E. #5 (Five) Claim, which is described as follows (fill out one of the two sections below):

This claim comprises the Southeast Quarter of Section 3 (three) Township 32 South Range 7 East, of the Willamette Meridian, in the State of Oregon.
