

TERMINATION OF EASEMENT

THIS TERMINATION OF EASEMENT is made this 19th day of April, 1989, by the United States of America, by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

WHEREAS, Chiloquin Timber Company granted to the United States of America an easement dated February 27, 1964, recorded March 9, 1964, in Vol. 351 of Deeds, page 431, and recorded July 20, 1964, in Vol. 354 of Deeds, page 551 and rerecorded September 1, 1964, in Vol. 355 of Deeds, page 639, records of Klamath County, Oregon, hereinafter called the Initial Easement, did convey to the United States easements for Manville Road, Project 35015, over and across the following described lands:

T. 35 S., R. 7 E., W.M.,
sec. 35, S1/2SE1/4;
sec. 36, SW1/4SW1/4.

WHEREAS, by easement deed dated October 20, 1964, recorded October 26, 1964, in Vol. 357 of Deeds, page 164, County of Klamath, State of Oregon, hereinafter called the Subsequent Easement, Chiloquin Timber Company did grant to the United States of America an easement for the same road over the land of Chiloquin Timber Company, and;

WHEREAS, both the United States of America and Chiloquin Timber Company do intend and agree that the Subsequent Easement shall supersede the Initial Easement, and shall govern the rights of the United States of America and Chiloquin Timber Company for use of the land and the road thereon subject to such Subsequent Easement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the grant by Chiloquin Timber Company of said Subsequent Easement, the Government hereby releases, relinquishes, and discharges to Chiloquin Timber Company, and its successors in interest, all rights created by and arising from or out of the aforesaid Initial Easement except for such rights also granted and continued in the Subsequent Easement. Said Subsequent Easement is in no way affected by this termination and shall remain in full force.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America, by the Director of Lands, Pacific Northwest Region, Forest Service, pursuant to the delegation of authority dated August 22, 1984 (49 F.R. 34283), has executed this Termination of Easement on the day and year first above written.

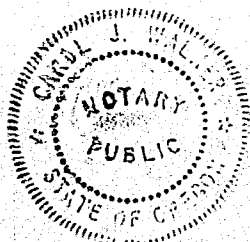
